

# Wade Richmond Scholarship: To the Applicant

The Wade Richmond Scholarship is awarded yearly in the spring by First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio and administered by the San Antonio Area Foundation.

## **To apply, you should**

be an active member of First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio through religious education, Young Religious Unitarian Universalists, or volunteerism; for specific membership requirements, see DLRE Sheri Phillabaum or Rev. Bret Lortie.

possess the basic personal qualities that Wade Richmond had and admired: helpful, compassionate, thinking person pursuing your own career and interests, but interested in making a personal effort to improve the world around you.

Also, this scholarship should help realize an opportunity that may not otherwise be available (e.g. it might enable you to attend a more expensive school than would have been generally considered or it would help ease a possible hardship in such a decision).

## **How to apply:**

Complete a scholarship application, form attached. Your application will include an application form, two essays, two letters of recommendation, and your high school transcripts which should indicate your current grade point average. Details are on the application form.

## **Who will choose the scholarship recipient:**

The selection committee includes the past, present, and current presidents of the congregation as well as the co-chair of the youth religious education council.

## **What happens if you receive the scholarship:**

You will be expected to write a report of your college work and accomplishments each year to the First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio each year. This report will be submitted to the monthly newsletter as an article through the Director of Lifespan Religious Education.

The scholarship is renewable for up to four years of academic work, contingent upon full enrollment and a satisfactory grade point average!
