_____ **Classroom Teacher (35 hrs. total volunteer time)**

Teach on Classroom Sundays (second and third Sundays of each month) as part of a team. A Sept. – May commitment, 3 hours a month. Training, lesson plans and lots of support provided.

_____ **Social Action Team (15 hrs)**

Team members needed who can help develop and carry out plans for Social Action projects. A Sept.- May commitment with 1.5 – 2 hrs a month

_____ **Art Team (5 hrs.)**

Be part of a team that helps implement Art Sunday plans. 1.5 – 2 hrs. commitment needed for the fifth Sundays of the year (Sept., Dec., March).

_____ **Welcome Team**

Be part of a team that welcomes families and orients them on Sunday mornings. A 20 – 30 minute commitment on alternating Sundays.

_____ **Coming of Age Facilitator (45 - 55 hrs., 30 – 40 hrs.)**

A marker of the transition period between childhood and young adulthood, the Coming of Age program is for 9th and 10th graders. Includes at least one weekend retreat. Training and support provided.

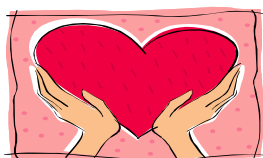
_____ **Club M2U Advisor**

Be part of an advising team that helps facilitate meetings of our High School youth group. Some weekend travel required. Training and support provided. 1 – 1.5 hr. commitment on Sunday afternoons, occasional activities evenings, weekends, and summers.

_____ **Our Whole Lives Facilitator**

Train to teach one or more levels of our human sexuality program. Commitment time ranges between levels. Comprehensive training and support provided.

_____ **Summer RE Leader (3 – 6 hrs.)**

Lead or assist groups of 8 – 12 kids in summer lessons. 1 – 1.5 hour commitment on Sunday mornings at 9:30- 10:30 from June through August.

_____ **Summer camp teacher (2-30 hours).** The camp runs for one week, Monday through Friday, usually in July.

_____ **Youth Religious Education Council.** This is the coordinating and decision-making body for our program, and meets on the first Wednesday of every month in the evening. Each member claims a particular area of responsibility, such as social action or worship.
